

Wedding

The text of the Episcopal wedding service teaches that marriage “signifies to us the mystery of the union between Christ and his Church, and Holy Scripture commends it to be honored among all people.” (Book of Common Prayer page 423). In the Episcopal tradition, marriage is seen as a sacrament and our wedding service is understood to be primarily a service of worship where two people commit themselves to one another in a holy and intimate way that bears witness to Christ’s love for his people.
